Church Tour Sunday 12th May 2019

St George, Six Mile Bottom CB8 0UN
Grid Ref TL581568

Six Mile Bottom is on the A1304 6 miles south-west of Newmarket. The church is beside the minor road leading south-east to Brinkley, just past the level crossing. There is parking within the precinct, but the access is very narrow; swing right, across the road, before attempting to enter, so as to approach the entrance straight on.

Return to the A1304 and turn right. Continue 2 miles and turn left, signed to Swaffham Bulbeck. Continue $\frac{3}{4}$ mile and cross over the A1303 with care. Continue $2\frac{1}{3}$ miles and turn left at T-junction, signed to Swaffham Bulbeck and Bottisham. Continue $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and at T-junction turn left on to High Street, signed to Bottisham and Cambridge. St Mary's Swaffham Bulbeck is immediately on the right.

St Mary, Swaffham Bulbeck CB25 0LX

Park along the right of High Street in front of the churchyard.

Return along High Street and at the village green turn right on to the B1102. Continue just over 3 miles to Burwell. As the B1102 bends left the church is on the left.

St Mary, Burwell CB25 0HB
Grid Ref TL590661

Park in front of the Guildhall, which is behind the church, or along High Street B1102. For those with limited mobility there are a very few spaces on the driveway in the churchyard, reached through the double gates which will be open. On this occasion the guided tour will take place on arrival, followed by tea in the church. WCs in church and Guildhall.
