



**Cambridgeshire Historic Churches Trust**  
**Church Tour Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

**All Saints, Shepreth SG8 6RG**  
**Grid Ref TL393475**

Shepreth is just northwest of the A10, midway between M11 Junction 11 and Royston. The church is beside High Street, south of the village. From the A10 take "Frog End", the more southerly of the two turnings signed to Shepreth. There is a car park to the right of the lane beside the churchyard.

Return to the A10 and turn left. Continue 1 mile and turn right signed to Foxton. Continue  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile through the village and turn right into Hardman Road.

**St Laurence's, Foxton CB22 6RP**  
**Grid Ref TL414484**

There is a car park on the left with access to the church's south door.

Return to the High Street, turn right, and continue as the road bends right. After  $1\frac{3}{4}$  miles at the crossroads turn left signed to Newton. Continue  $2\frac{1}{4}$  miles to the centre of Newton village. Teas and WC are in the Memorial Hall at the crossroads. The church is  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile along Town Street running left from the crossroads.

**St Margaret's, Newton CB22 7PE**  
**Grid Ref TL435492**

If you are able, please park along the left of Town Street and walk to the Memorial Hall and back. If not, please park alongside Harston Road to the left of the Hall and move your vehicle to Town Street after leaving the Hall.

**Please have consideration for local people and other road users - do not obstruct access, nor obstruct traffic.**
