**Kirtling – 1 Our Lady Immaculate & St Philip Neri
CB8 9PA Grid Ref TL685574
2 All Saints' CB8 9PA TL686576**

Kirtling is on a minor road 6 miles south-east of Newmarket. The two churches are some 600 yards apart, about a mile north-west of the village centre. Park along the north-east side of the road between the almshouses and church No 1 (taking care not to obstruct driveways) or alongside the lane leading to church No 2. Following the first visit, go on foot to the second church if you are able to do so.

Go south-east towards the village centre and turn right signed to Woodditton. Continue through the village 1 mile and turn right, again signed to Woodditton. Continue 2³/₄ miles and in Woodditton turn left signed to Stetchworth. Continue 2¹/₄ miles and in Stetchworth turn left signed to Dullingham. Continue 1 mile into Dullingham and at the crossroads turn left on to the B1061. After 200 yards turn left into Church Close. The Taylor Hall, where tea is to be served, and the church, are at the end of Church Close.

Park at the Taylor Hall or on the tarmacadam circle opposite (NOT, please, on the grass). If there is insufficient space there, park along nearby roads.
